

## **Scholarship Application Form (2017)**

Terms and Conditions: To qualify, you must have a minimum grade 12 diploma or be completing your grade 12 diploma by June 2017 and be accepted to or be enrolled in a post-secondary program at a recognized institution, such as a university, community college, private institution or school of trade where tuition is payable by the student and / or duly recognized under the Canada Student Loan Program. Persons with disabilities completing a degree part time may apply. In addition, you must be a full or part-time employee of a Greater Moncton Chamber of Commerce ("GMCC") member in good standing **or** the child or spouse of the member or their employee. To qualify for the scholarship, you must be under 25 years of age at the time you commence the program. Eligibility is limited to Chamber members residing within the region (Westmorland, Kent or Albert counties).

Please note: Previous winners are not eligible.

Three (3) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded at the GMCC Annual General Meeting on May 16, 2017.

- Curriculum vitae or equivalent showing your work , community or extra-curricular involvement
- Two (2) letters of references by non-related parties (teacher, community leader, employer, etc.) must include and support the three areas of
  evaluation: academic/extra-curricular achievement, community/volunteer work, paid work achievements. Recommendations should be
  substantial and attest to the candidate's overall contributions and abilities;
- One page typed essay of 250 words on the topic of how your chosen field of education will help you achieve your personal goals and to contribute to
  the development of our community.
- A current transcript of academic achievement (marks);
- Letter by a member of the GMCC attesting that I am an employee of the member or I am the child or spouse of a member or their employee
